Permission Forms and Waivers

You must complete a permission form for each excursion your child wishes to attend.

Permission forms are contained in the middle of this booklet. Please remove them carefully, complete the information, and return the form to the Educational Leader before the last week of term.

Excursions

On excursion days, it is important children arrive at least 20 minutes before the bus is due to leave; the bus will not wait for those who are late. On non-excursion days, children can arrive at any time.

What to bring

Please bring these items along each day:

- Water bottle
- Weather appropriate clothing
- Closed-toe shoes (no Crocs or thongs)
- A wide-brimmed hat (no baseball caps)
- Sunscreen
- Medication, if applicable

Remember: A wide-brimmed hat and sunscreen are required during the warmer months from September to April. No hat; no outdoor play.

Breakfast is based on:

- Cereals and grain-based food. Wholemeal or wholegrain choices are available
- Milk, yoghurt, cheese, or dairy alternatives. Low-fat options are available

Afternoon tea is based on:

- Fruit and vegetables
- Milk, yoghurt, cheese, or dairy alternatives. Low-fat choices are available

The menu does not include any of the following:

- Sugary drinks, including juice and flavoured sports waters
- Confectionery
- Deep-fried foods
- Pastries
- Fast food
- Processed meats
- High-fat, high-salt and high-sugar snack foods
- Ice-creams and icy poles

Cancellations

It's your responsibility to advise us when your child cannot attend OSHC by calling **(03) 4418 2128**, emailing **oshc@lifely.org.au** or via the **Xplor app**.

Non-illness related absences must be reported by 4 pm the day before your child's booking. While absence due to illness can be reported before 10 am on the day of the booking.

If your child's permanent placement and they do not attend for two consecutive weeks without notice, their place may be cancelled. Cancellation may also apply to families whose children accumulate ten late cancellations in one term.

If your child is at risk of losing a permanent position, you will be notified via a phone call and in writing.

The loss of a permanent position does not exclude you from reapplying for another permanent place in the future or making a casual booking.

Lifely aims to implement processes to ensure that the OSHC service operates efficiently and effectively and that future planning considerations for OSHC are met through maintaining appropriate records for children's bookings and cancellations. This process will ensure that the future needs of the Lifely and OSHC participants can be met through the maintenance of appropriate waiting lists.

Where a child is at risk of losing a permanent position, the parent will be notified by the Nominated Supervisor/ Project Manager via a phone call and in writing.

The loss of a permanent position in no way excludes the child from reapplying for another permanent place in the future or availing themselves of any casual vacancies that become available.

Lifely aims to implement processes to ensure that the OSHC service operates efficiently and effectively and that future planning considerations for OSHC are met through maintaining appropriate records for children's bookings and cancellations. This process will ensure that the future needs of the Lifely and OSHC participants can be met through the maintenance of appropriate waiting lists.

Behaviour

If a child's behaviour seriously affects the safety of educators or other children, their family will be contacted and asked to make alternative care arrangements for their child or children.


